Pine Street provides direct access to Level 1, while Olive Way and 9th Avenue entrances provide access to the Level 1 elevators.

Service animal relief locations

All service animals needing relief must be taken outside the building on the street-level. The Summit building does not have designated service animal relief areas available, and the Garden Terrace on level 3 is not an option.

- Pay attention to your instincts: If something doesn't feel right, you can always walk into a business/hotel for help.
